The course will then focus on Digital Health by nursing process - assessment, planning, implementation and review. CHIME is thrilled that **Gwen Moulster OBE** is joining our faculty and will take students through the Learning Disability Nursing Model: a framework for practice.

Learning will be enhanced with case studies and examples of best practice to demonstrate how digital health can deliver better care for people with learning disabilities.

Finally, we will focus on you and how RNLDs are true change agents in digital health. We'll help you use your personal capital to make change happen and how to use networks as levers for change. This inspiring session will be aimed at building RNLDs to be leaders in patient-centred digital health.
